6. **MINUTES OF THE MEETING – 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2012**

6a. Matters raised from the Minutes

- Dog Fouling – This is becoming a concern in the village, a minority of owners are not cleaning up after their dogs. Flintshire C.C Environmental Dept have been asked to arrange for someone to clean the pavements along from the Farmers Arms pub to the main road along Ffordd y Llan. There are adequate dog bins in the area, there is no excuse to leave the dog mess on the pavement. Reports have been forwarded to FCC Environmental Dept and PCSO Andrea Ellis giving descriptions of the owners and their dogs and the times the dogs are walked.
- The clerk will follow up e-mails forwarded to Clarke & Kent BMX contractors with reference to inspecting the track and carrying out repair and surfacing work, an inspection should have taken place over the Christmas holiday period.
- Tendering of BMX Track, Queen Street playing fields. As agreed by TCC an advert will be displayed in the Treuddyn News. The track will require approximately 14 to 16 cuts from March to October 2012, all cuttings to be taken away.
- Flintshire C.C Council Housing Ballot. Tact Dome visited Treuddyn on January 26<sup>th</sup> 2012, but unfortunately parked down by the Bull Ring, residents were expecting the van to be parked on Ffordd y Rhos. Notices forwarded by Tact Dome apologising for the mistake, have been displayed on the notice boards, a contact number is also available.
- Dwr Cymru Welsh Water - A meeting was held at the village hall on January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2012, in which was also open to members of the public. The meeting was to discuss Treuddyn Waste Water Treatment Works (WwTW) to improve the facilities in the village, and to facilitate new developments. Flintshire C.C had put forward £245,000 in which Dwr Cymru had received towards the upgrade of the Treatment Works. Mr Rhidian Clement, Principal Planner and colleagues from Dwr Cymru, with representative of the Environment Agency and various officers and members of the County Council were present at the meeting. It was at the meeting that Dwr Cymru's change of stance in relation to improvement of the Treuddyn WwTW was not understood. Mr Davies – Interim head of Legal and Democratic Services F.C.C has asked Dwr Cymru to provide the County Council with more details, in particular a copy of the feasibility study update and review.
