Minutes of the Meeting held Wednesday 13 July, 2011 at the Meeting Room, Village Hall, Queen St. Treuddyn 7pm

4. **PUBLIC SESSION 6.50 pm to 7.00pm** – PCSO Andrea Ellis and Four members of the public

The Community Council welcomed members of the public. A report by a member of the public was given with reference to the on going noise disturbance at the Bus Shelter opposite Queen Street, there has been no change to the level of noise and abusive behaviour. PCSO Andrea Ellis stated that all incidents need to be logged and any disturbance and threatening behaviour should be reported on the 101 number. There has been delays on the 101 non emergency line, but if incidents are on going dial 999. Anti-social Behaviour Officers issue yellow cards, Andrea can also give out yellow cards. Monthly meetings are held with Social Services, Housing and the Police in which cases are put before an adjudication panel. Anyone causing damage, this is a crime. A public order can be issued to a person swearing and calling names. Areas with high incidence of anti-social behaviour will be targeted by local patrols. It is important that incidents are reported to the Police.

Update : PCSO Andrea Ellis gave an update of reported incidents in the local and surrounding area. Thefts of appliances from garden sheds has been the main target. The Police have advised to mark petrol appliances and take photographs. There has been one reported break in locally and three calls logged on Saturday 9 July, 2011.

5. **POST OFFICE DIVERSIFICATION FUND**

Talks are still on going with reference to a Post Office being sited in the village. County Cllr. Mrs Thomas is in contact with the 'Post Office' and proposals have been put forward to the 'Head of Housing', Flintshire C.C, to consider Hafan Deg premises being used two days a week.

8. **PENNAF / LOVELLS DEVELOPMENT**

It was agreed in principle to accept the proposals put forward by Pennaf/Lovells Development for use of the Parish owned drain, dependant on Flintshire C.C Legal Department reading through the document and giving advise. County Cllr. Mrs Thomas and the Clerk will act accordingly to the instructions given.

9. **INTERNAL AUDITORS REPORT – END OF YEAR ACCOUNTS 2010/11**

The accounts had been returned from the Internal Auditors in which there were no issues raised. The accounts will be forwarded on to the External Auditor's for their examination.

10. **CORRESPONDENCE**

1. Flintshire Summer Playscheme Programme 2011. The Playscheme will commence on July 20th for a period of five weeks finishing on Tuesday, August 23rd 2011. It was noted the Bilingual Playscheme had not been listed. The clerk will contact Janet Roberts, Play Development Officer to confirm the programme for the Bilingual sessions.

2. Household Recycling Centre Service in Flintshire. Cllr Mrs Thomas commented that fly tipping has decreased. Flintshire C.C is reviewing the provision of its Household Recycling Centre (HRC) service across the County. The following comments from Treuddyn C.C will be put forward - The Nercwys site is very good and well managed. The area is kept very clean and the gentlemen are very helpful.
3. Standards Conference – 5th October 2011. The theme this year is ‘Improving Standards’. The conference will be held at the Metropole Hotel in Llandrindod Wells. Members from Town and Community Councils who wish to attend this year need to inform Mandy Haslam by 1st September. The cost has not been confirmed but last years conference fee was £60 per delegate.
4. Standards Committee Annual Report – enclosed. Meeting with members of the Standards Committee – 10th October. The next meeting for Clerks and Members of Town and Community Councils to meet with the Flintshire Standards Committee will be held on Monday, 10 October at 6.30pm in the Council Chamber, Mold Town Council, Town Hall, Earl Road, Mold.
5. NWP - Street Lighting / The supervisor Mr Nick Hardy is currently on sick leave . Any street lighting faults are to be reported to Mr Warren Pugh until further notice. With reference to the Street Light Inspections being carried out by NWP this is no longer a requirement by Treuddyn C.C. The clerk will be holding a meeting with FCC street lighting department to discuss street light maintenance costs.

A meeting took place at the Queen St. playing field comprising a representative from the ‘Big Lottery Fund’ with Cllrs Jenny Smith & Gill Short. The equipment was reviewed, and the evidence of improvement to the area was noted. Cllr. Mrs Jenny Smith would be looking after the revenue stream over the next three years towards the biking courses, insurances etc, capital funding would be released on a one-off basis to fund the additional equipment. The ‘Big Lottery’ should be releasing the funds into TCC account in the next week..
